

ADMISSIONS POLICY

It is our intention to make our setting accessible to all children and families from the community of North Crawley & surrounding areas, into Milton Keynes.

In order to achieve this aim, we operate the following admissions policy.

- We ensure that the existence of the setting is widely advertised in places accessible to all sections of the community.
- We ensure that information about our setting is accessible - in written and spoken form - and, where appropriate, in different languages.
- We arrange our waiting list in birth order, along with required sessions/days.
- In addition we may take into account siblings already attending the setting.
- We welcome both fathers and mothers, other relations and other carers, including childminders in all our activities.
- We describe our setting and its practices in terms of how it treats individuals, regardless of their gender, special educational needs, disabilities, background, religion, ethnicity or competence in spoken English.
- We aim to ensure that children with disabilities are able to take a full part in the life of the setting.
- We monitor the gender and ethnic background of children joining the group to ensure that no accidental discrimination is taking place.
- We make our equal opportunities policy widely known.
- We are flexible about attendance patterns to accommodate the needs of individual children and families.
