- Monitor what children are accessing at school (filters)
- Teach children to ask for help and how to access help and support

School to monitor what children and staff are accessing on school devices

- Conduct

# Keeping children safe online

- Additional guidance from DoE
- Children need to understand the risks
- Must know how to raise concerns and when to seek help
- Includes keeping safe online at home
- Additional guidance should be given to parents
- DSL must know what the current risks are

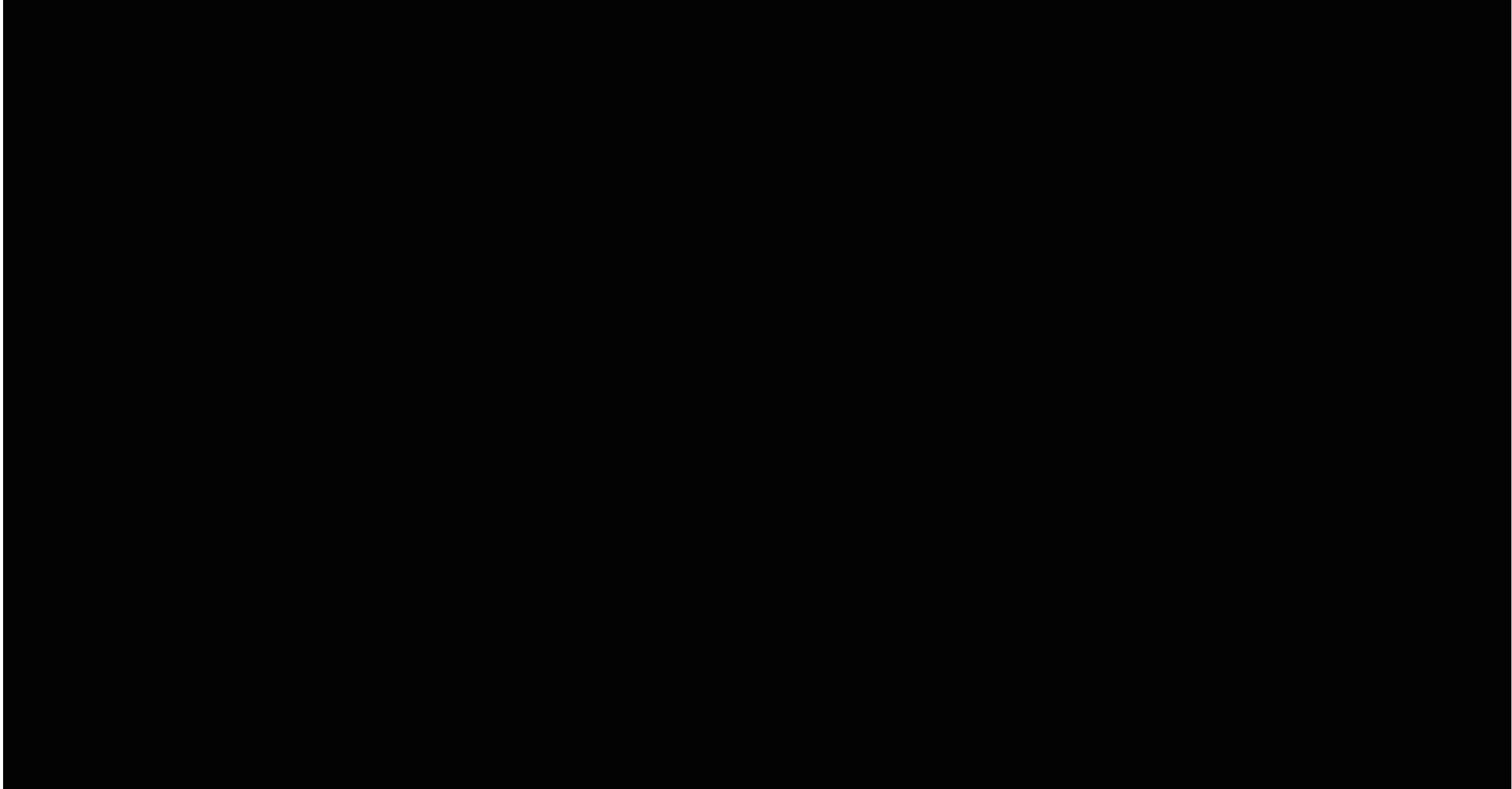
